Your journey Return journeys will depart from Oxenhope and Keighley, and will include a break half way round where you can stretch your legs and pose for photographs next to the engine.

On the train As part of a phased reopening, we're offering pre-booked return journeys using private compartments. These seat 1-8 people, and on Sundays we'll be using vintage and First Class stock rarely used on the Railway.

Facilities To keep everyone safe we've made some changes so your visit will be a bit different to normal.

The Oxenhope Exhibition Shed has been transformed to a spacious waiting room where you can see more engines up close, visit the pop-up shop, and enjoy refreshments from the café.

Dogs A maximum of two dogs are welcome to travel with you in the ex-British Railways coaches but not in the compartments of the Vintage coaches. Only assistance dogs will be allowed to travel on Sundays.

Tickets for your dog are £1 each, and please keep dogs off the carriage seats and on a lead when not on board the train.

Assistance dogs are free of charge.

Wheelchairs Due to the historic nature of the carriages, we are unable to lift wheelchairs into the compartments. Space for passengers who are unable to transfer from wheelchairs will be available in the Guards Van.

Carers Passengers who are only able to visit us with the assistance of a carer may claim a free carer's ticket for their carer, provided they purchase a full priced ticket for themselves. Those visitors who need to remain in their wheelchair for the journey can also claim a free ticket for one companion.
