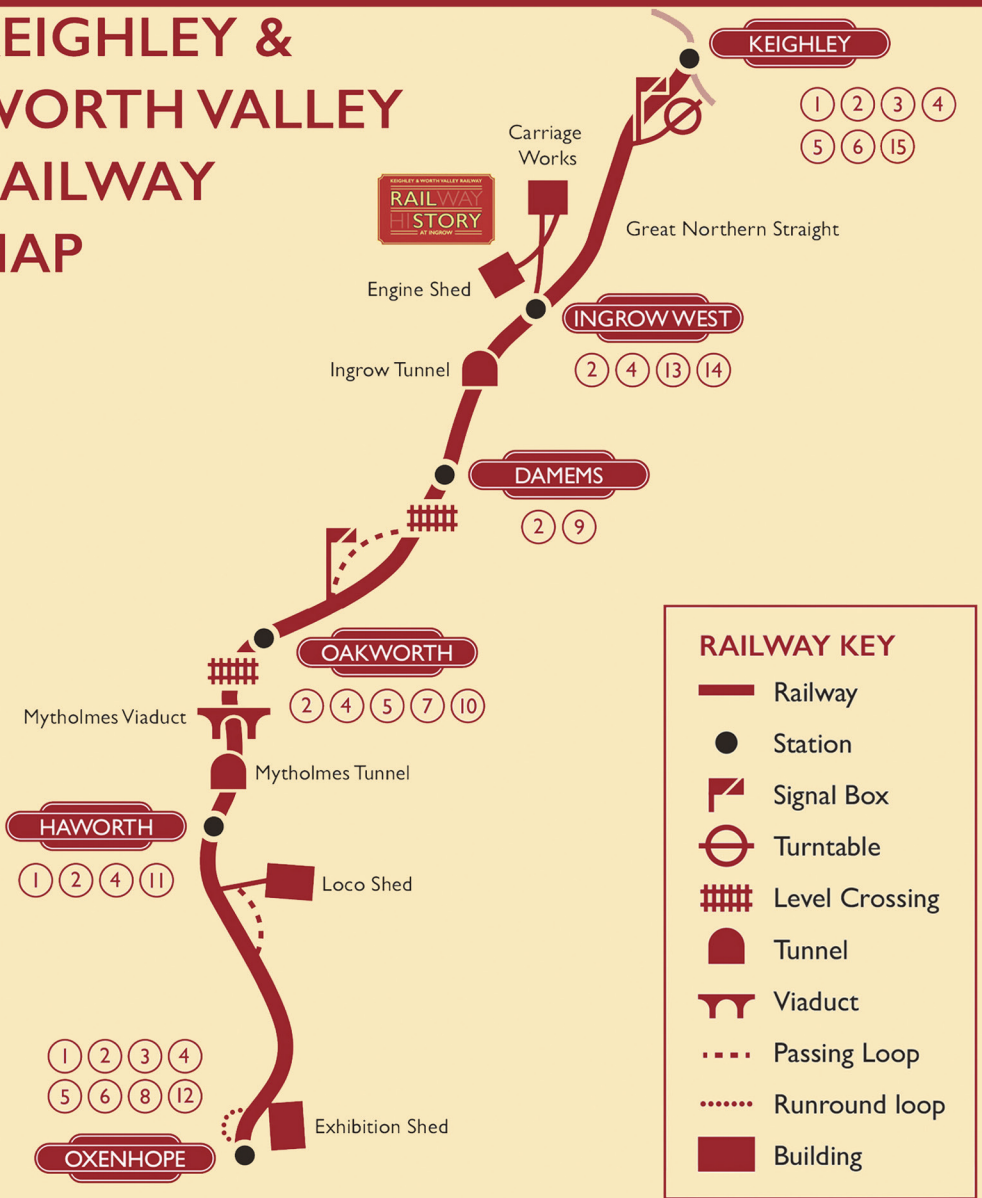


# KEIGHLEY & WORTH VALLEY RAILWAY MAP
